PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVAL OF MINUTES Charles Cook MOVED to approve the minutes from the January 31, 2017 WCTCC Meeting, and Ryan Kirsch SECONDED. No discussion. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT-For the record there was no public comment presented at the meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT Diane Figg reported all members should have received the reports. Ms. Figg continued reporting the WCTCC spent \$4,560.20 in 2017 which included advertising in the amount of \$162.70; audit of the WCTCC was \$1,900; insurances were \$1,822; legal fees were \$356.50; transcription of the meeting minutes was \$50; and website costs were \$269. We gained \$15.27 in interest.

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Our net last year was \$4,544.93 and the balance in the checking account is \$5,989.71 as of December 31, 2017.

Charles Cook **MOVED** to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented, and Diane Heming **SECONDED**. No discussion. **Motion carried**.

COMMITTEE REPORTS-No Reports.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT-

(1) Tax Collector Contract Ending 2018/Contract Extension. Solicitor Maiello reported the original agreement included a first amendment and that amendment expires at the end of this year. The WCTCC will have to take action with respect to extending or modifying the current agreement. In the current agreement the fee structure is 1.42% which was reduced from 1.45% during extension negotiations for the current contract. Solicitor Maiello recommended starting discussions in regard to the expiration of the contract due to the infrequency of the WCTCC meeting throughout the year. Solicitor Maiello stated the contract does not have to be re-bid; an extension of the current contract can be negotiated. After discussions regarding Berkheimer's performance including collections and reporting, the consensus was to extend the contract.

Charles Cook MOVED to extend the current tax collection contract with Berkheimer for three years, through 2021, and Joe Koluder SECONDED. No further discussion. Motion carried.

AGENDA

- 2018 Budget. Diane Figg presented the 2018 Budget with no assessment in 2018.
 Caprice Mills MOVED to approve the 2018 Budget as presented by Diane Figg, and Diane Heming SECONDED. No further discussion. Motion carried.
- 2. Selection of 2018 Operating Board. The WCTCC Operating Board must have 10 members; five members representing School Districts and five members representing Municipalities and no more than two can come from within the same School District boundaries. Scott Sistek stated all members currently serving on the Operating Board have expressed an interest to remain on the Board with the exception of Jennifer Callahan; and Paul Sroka has accepted appointment to the Board to fill her vacancy.

 Charles Cook MOVED to approve the members for appointment/reappointment to the 2018

WCTCC Operating Board as presented, and Jennifer Callahan **SECONDED**. No further discussion. **Motion carried**.

- 3. Statement of Financial Interests. Scott Sistek reminded the WCTCC members the Statement of Financial Interests Forms required by the State Ethics Commission are due to Caprice Mills by May 1, 2018.
- 4. 2019 Assessment. A concern regarding determining the 2019 assessment amount to be included in the respective Political Subdivisions' budgets was brought to the attention of the WCTCC. Diane Figg recommended a \$20,000 assessment for 2019. Charles Cook MOVED to approve the 2019 Assessment in the amount of \$20,000, and Joe Koluder SECONDED. No further discussion. Motion carried.
